We are asking

individuals to submit their names, phone numbers, addresses, and number of people in their families to let us know they would like to use our pick-up option. We will do our best to fill orders received by Friday to be ready for pick up on Thursday of the following week. However, we will also contact individuals by phone to confirm when their orders will be ready. *NOTE: All restrictions on geographic area served and number of times individuals can come in will continue to apply.* Order forms are available through the Church's Facebook pages and website, as well as on the Dayton and Mulberry town Facebook pages.

Donations that have been made of food items and grocery bags continue to be most greatly appreciated! Just drop off donations at the office any Thursday between 9:30 a.m. and 11:30 p.m. *Bring your receipt to the office, and you'll be reimbursed.*

- Decorated card stock square (5"x 5")
- Scissors
- Hole punch
- 2 one-inch circles of card stock
- Glue
- Pipe cleaner (3 inches)
- Drinking straw

What you do:

- Fold the square corner to corner to form an X. Unfold.
- 2. To make spokes, cut the four creases until an inch from the center.
- 3. Punch a hole in the middle of the square, near the tips of each spoke, and in the middle of each circle.
- 4. Fold each spoke toward the center, lining up the holes. Glue in place.
- 5. Wrap one end of the pipe cleaner around the top of the straw. Thread a circle, the pinwheel, and the remaining circle onto the pipe cleaner.
- 6. Roll the pipe cleaner end into a ball. Then spin!

SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE

Spring has arrived! Soon students will be out of school for that long-awaited Summer Break. For those students that are graduating from high school, it is time for making huge decisions regarding the next step in their lives. If college is in the future plans, NOW is the time to think about applying for a scholarship from Memorial Presbyterian Church.



Scholarship Fund

The Scholarship Fund was established as an outreach ministry in 2000 by an anonymous donor. Through that initial vision and through the generosity of several donors since its inception, the Scholarship Fund has been available to our youth for monetary support. In order to qualify for a scholarship, the applicant must meet as many of the following qualifications as possible:

- demonstrate a need for financial assistance
- be nominated by a member of the Dayton Memorial Presbyterian Church (does not have to be a member of the Dayton Memorial Presbyterian Church)
- have graduated from a local high school
- be enrolled in a four-year degree program

Note that the amount of the Scholarship Awards varies each year based on the availability of funds and the merits of each applicant.

In order to be considered for this scholarship, a student has to meet initial qualifications of demonstrating financial need and continued qualifications including outstanding personal conduct and passing grades in all subjects studied. The first step is filling out the application required by the Scholarship Committee. (This application form can be found on the Church Website **www.daytonpres.org** under the "NEWS" tab.) The next step is including the "FINANCIAL AID ELIGIBILITY FORM" PROVIDED BY THE COLLEGE the student is planning to attend. The last step is submitting the aforementioned requirements to either Cathy Hancook or Nancy Edwards by the **June 15, 2022, deadline.** The Scholarship Committee will review all applications received and may contact the applicants for further information if needed. Those chosen to receive a scholarship will be awarded their check and recognition during a designated Church Service.
